

# ANNUAL FALL CLEAN-UP SATURDAY (10/28)

Saturday October 28, 2017 (*Rain backup date Saturday, November 4th*)

## HOW CLEAN-UP WORKS

- **ALL** Members are required to participate as a fulfillment of membership  
*Non-members are welcome to participate*
- Start time *9:30am*. Meeting location will be determined by Ward Rep  
(UMN Land Care Services-mulch machines to follow)
- Each ward will be provided equipment *rakes, brooms and garbage bags*
  - **Ward by Ward Clean-up**--*garbage, leaves, twigs & branches, unwanted items*
  - Pick up **ALL GARBAGE** within the ward and around dumpster areas
  - Collect **TWIGS & BRANCHES** into piles along curb/sidewalk for pick-up
  - Dispose of all **UNWANTED** or **ABANDONED** items left around ward
  - **CLEAR** toys, bikes and lawn items for mulch machines to pass
  - Rake **LEAVES 6 feet** away from buildings, trees or fences into flat GRASS area. \***DO NOT MAKE PILES**-simply rake leaves away from building in a SINGLE LINE formation. This will allow the mulch machines smooth pick up accessibility.
  - **REMOVE** all non-organic material from leaves (trash/large twigs)
  - **Clean out** community gardens free of garbage and weeds
- **Clean your yard area**-(**\*yard inspections will be 1 week after clean-up day**)
  - Each household yard area needs to be cleaned and organized
  - Storage area organized-all items inside bin
  - Front & back flower beds are clear of weeds-non-flower materials
  - Lawn items organized and clear for mowers & mulch machines
  - All bikes must be claimed and organized(*any abandoned bikes after clean-up will be removed*)

**\*Applicable yard fines will be imposed during yard inspection for non-compliance**

**ONE-BEDROOM BUILDINGS**

  - Flowers beds around buildings must be cleaned out
  - Storage areas organized and items stowed away
  - Pick up all trash
  - Clean inside building common areas
  - **ALL** items in hallway **MUST** be removed & cleared (NO items in hallway)
- If your household is unable to attend inform your Ward Rep  
*Be advised of the following fulfillment duty alternatives:*
  - Assigned pre-clean up ward duty (pick up trash around ward, rake within ward or conduct light outages survey)
  - Stock laundry room supplies
  - Volunteer for a programs event
  - Additional Laundry Duty
